



**DRAFT EMERGENCY RESOLUTION No. 5)
CONDEMNATION OF PRESIDENT TEMER**

**The 30th World Congress of Public Services International (PSI),
meeting in Geneva, Switzerland, on 30th October to 3rd November 2017**

The Brazilian delegation proposes a Motion of Condemnation of President Temer, who yesterday issued a Provisional Measure which is detrimental to all federal public sector workers and to the Brazilian nation.

The Provisional Measure, which derives from Constitutional Amendment 95 that froze investments for 20 years, cancels the hardly-negotiated rights of federal public servants provided for in the law, by deferring the readjustments already negotiated and increasing the social contributions from 11 to 14 percent.

This governmental initiative, which will be applied to all Brazilian public sector workers, is part of the neoliberal guidelines for the plundering of public services, the annihilation of the welfare state, and the death of the rule of law.
